- 3. Continue to perform the role with best practices and pursue overseas qualifications and local recognition, gain accreditation and acceptance in the medical communities for quality service provision.
- 4. Partner with NGOs & Communities to strengthen comprehensive care to child patients.
- 5. Work with different professional bodies and Universities to conduct evidence based research about the service improvement and sustainability of Hospital Play Services.
- 6. Advocate Hospital Play Services through participating media promotion and advocacy events.
